

FIGURE S3. Genome maps of the eleven strains sequenced in this study and HH01. The innermost rings indicate the GC content (black) and GC skew (purple/green). The outer rings represent the genomes of the following isolates and two type strains in different colorings: A) *J. lividum* (bright blue), MP5059B (bright red), HH104 (turquoise), HH106 (yellow), HH107 (pink), HH100 (green), HH103 (wine red), HH102 (blue) of the Oxal group, related to the genus *Janthinobacterium* and B) the OxalI strains, affiliated with the genus *Duganella* HH105 (green), HH01 (petrol), *D. phyllosphaerae* (red) and HH101 (orange). Regions with high levels of divergence are marked with a numbered asterisk.
